BY DELETING THEREFROM ALL REFERENCE TO TWO HOUR PARKING AND INSERTING THE FOLLOWING IN LIEU THEREOF:-

- (i) Two hour parking is allowed at the rate of five cents per hour for not more than 2 hours 2 5¢ pieces or 1 -10¢ pieces
- (ii) Two hour parking is allowed at the rate of ten cents per hour for not more than two hours 2 10¢ pieces.
- (iii) Wherever in this by-law reference is made to 5¢ piece, that coin shall be designated on the meter as "Nickel"; and wherever in this by-law reference is made to 10¢ piece, that coin shall be designated on the meter as "Dime", and the plural in each case shall apply mutatis mutandis.
- 10. This By-law shall come into force and effect from the date after final approval thereof by the Ontario Department of Transport.
