1. THAT Clause (1) of SECTION SIXTEEN be repealed and the following substituted therefor.
(1) Municipal Officials and Police Vehicles An authorized municipal official
and vehicles of the North Bay Police Department in that area set out on the south side of McIntyre Street from Ferguson Street westerly 180 feet and on the west side of Ferguson Street from McIntyre Street southeriy 125 feet, at any time daily, Monday to Saturday, both inclusive.

9. THAT "SCHEDULE K" be amended as follows:-
i) Two hour parking is allowed at the rate of five cents
(ii) Two hour parking is allowed at the rate of ten cents per hour for not more than two hours 2-10d pieces.
(iii) Wherever in this by-1aw reference is made to $5 ¢$ piece, that coin shall be designated on the meter as "Nickel"; and wherever in this by-1aw reference is made to $10 \not \subset$ piece, that coin shall be designated on the meter as "Dime", and the plural in each case shall apply mutatis mutandis.
10. This By-1aw shall come into force and effect from the date after final approval thereof by the ontario Department of Transport.
