BEING a BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to enter into an Agreement with persons therein named for sharing or contributing to the capital cost of a housing project.

WHEREAS the several Veterans as listed in the within By-Law have applied to the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to assist in the capital cost of their various dwellings.

UNDER THTE PROVISIONS OF R. S. O. 1946, CHAPTER 71, SUBSFICTION 21 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT in each of the houses owned by the hereinafter named Veterans the City of North Bay will contribute in cash to the said Veteran a sum equal to ten per cent ( $10 \%$ ) of the capital cost of the same as is required to be paid by the Veteran under his agreement of sale, provided, however, that in no case shall the amount advanced to the Veteran exceed $\$ 750.00$.
