## BY-LAW NUMBER 618.

BEING a By-law to provide for the Licensing, Regulating and Governing Bill Posters, Advertising Sign Painters, Bulletin Board Painters, Sign Posters and Bill Distributors, and for prohibiting the posting up or distributing of posters, pictures or hand-bills, within the Town of North Bay, which are indecent or tend to corrupt morals.

By-law 618

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the Town of North Bay deemitt advisable to pass a By-law for Licensing, Regulating and Governing Bill Posters, Advertising Sign Painters, Bulletin Board Painters, Sign Posters and Bill Distributors, and for prohibiting the posting-up or distributing of posters, pictures or hand bills within the Town of North Bay, which are indecent or tend to corrupt morals,

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY enacts as follows:-

1. THAT all Bill Posters, Advertising Sign Painters, Bulletin Moard Painters, Sign Posters and Bill Distributors within the Townoof North Bay, shall be required to pay an annual license of .02¢ per sq. foot, guthorizing them respectively to carry on their said trade, calling or business in the Town of North Bay.

2. THAT the License shall cover a period of one year from the date thereof.

3. THAT all persons are prohibited from posting up, or distributing posters, pictures or hand bills within the Town of North Bay, which are indecent or tend to corrupt morals.

4. THAT any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law, shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$20.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs; and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs, forthwith, the said penalty and costs, or costs, only, may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender; and in case of there being no distress found, out of which such penalty can be levied, the convicting Magistrate may commit the offender to the Common Gaol of the Town of North

Bay, with or without hard labour, for any period not exceeding six calendar months, unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.
