

BY-LAW No. 5 4 3

By-Law 543*

WHEREAS under and by virtue of Section 4 of Regulation passed by the Fuel Controller of Canada, Municipalities are authorized to pass a By-law appointing a Municipal Fuel Commissioner.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to pass such a By-law.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, and it is hereby enacted as follows;-

1. That A. TANDY be and is hereby appointed as Fuel Controller.

That the duties of the Fuel Controller so appointed shall be.

(a) To co-ordinate the work of the Fuel dealers in apportioning and delivering coal during any period of fuel scarcity within such Municipality.

(b) To institute when deemed necessary a system of controlling retail coal deliveries through orders on dealers within the Municipality, issued by the Fuel Commissioner.

(c) Generally to assist the Fuel Administrator in enforcing such regulations as may from time to time be made by the Fuel Controller for Canada.

2. That the salary of the Municipal Fuel Controller be \$25.00 per month.

3. That this By-law shall go into force and take effect on and after the 24th. day of September, 1918.
