



AND WHEREAS the amount of the existing debenture debt of the Corporation (exclusive of the Local Improvement debt, secured by special rates or assessment) is \$562,819.62 and no part of the principal or interest is in arrears.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Board of Health have reported in writing that it is of the opinion that it is necessary in the interests of the public health, that the sanitary sewerage system at present existing in the said Town should be extended, for which the plans, specifications, and application have been approved by the said Provincial Board of Health as follows:-

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, as follows:-

1. That for the purpose aforesaid, there shall be borrowed on the credit of the Corporation at large, the sum of Forty-six Thousand and Nineteen Dollars (\$46,019) and debentures shall be issued therefore in sums of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100)

each bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum and having coupons attached thereto for the payment of the interest.

2. The debentures shall all bear the same date and shall be issued within one year after the day on which this By-law is passed, and may bear any date within such year, and shall be payable in twenty annual instalments, during the twenty years next after the time when the same are issued, and the respective amounts of principal and interest payable in each of such years shall be as set forth in Schedule "B".

3. The debentures as to both principal and interest may be expressed in Canadian Currency or Sterling Money of Great Britain, at the rate of One Pound Sterling for each Four Dollars and Eighty-six and two-third cents, and shall be payable at the Royal Bank of Canada, North Bay, Ont.

4. The Mayor of the Corporation shall sign and issue the debentures and interest coupons and the same shall also be signed by the Treasurer of the Corporation, and the debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation.

5. During the twenty years the currency of the Debentures, the sum of Four Thousand and Twelve Dollars and Fourteen Cents (\$4012.14) shall be raised annually for the payment of the debts and interest as follows:-

The sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred and thirty-nine dollars and ~~Fifty-two~~ <sup>thirty-nine</sup> cents (\$2,739.~~52~~<sup>52</sup>) is to be raised annually for the Corporation's portion of the costs, and the interest thereon, and shall be levied and raised annually by a special rate sufficient therefore, over and above all other rates on all the rateable property in the Municipality at the same time and in the same manner as other rates.

For the payment of the Owners' portion of the costs and interest thereon, the special assessment set forth in the said Special Assessment Roll is hereby imposed upon the lands liable therefore therein set forth, which said special assessment aforesaid, with a sum sufficient to cover interest thereon at the rate aforesaid, shall be payable in twenty annual instalments of One Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy-Two Dollars and Sixty-two Cents (\$1272.~~52~~<sup>52</sup>) and for that purpose an equal annual special rate of .0872 dollars per foot frontage is hereby imposed upon each lot entered in the said special assessment roll, according to the assessed frontage thereof, over and above all other rates and taxes, which special rate shall be collected annually by the Collector of taxes for the Corporation at the same time and in the same manner as the other rates.

6. The Debentures may contain any clause providing for the registration thereof, authorized by any Statute relating to Municipal Debentures in force at the time of the issue thereof.

7. The amount of the loan authorized by this By-law may be consolidated with the amount of any loan authorized by any other Local Improvement By-law, including the same with such other loans in a consolidating By-law, authorizing the borrowing of the aggregate thereof as one loan, and the issue of debentures for such loan in one consecutive issue pursuant to the provisions of the Statute in that behalf.

8. Any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute

the special rates imposed thereon by paying such sum as when invested at six per cent per annum, will provide an annuity sufficient to pay the special rates for the unexpired portion of the term as they fall due.

This By-law shall take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
