## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 91-85

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE THE SUM OF \$332,859 FOR RENOVATIONS TO MEMORIAL GARDENS

WHEREAS the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 208, Paragraph 57 provides for the work herein described;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Renovations to Memorial Gardens at a total estimated cost of \$332,859 as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law, are hereby authorized.
- That the Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to borrow from time to time from any bank or person by way of promissory note or notes, temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the aforesaid expenditures pending the issue and sale of debentures hereinafter referred to, but in no event shall the aggregate of such borrowing exceed the amount limited in this by-law.
- Any promissory note or notes issued pursuant to
  Paragraph 2 hereof shall be sealed with the seal of
  The Corporation of the City of North Bay and signed
  by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor and the Treasurer of the
  City of North Bay.
- The debentures to be issued when the work is completed to pay for the cost of such work shall bear interest at such rate as Council may determine and shall be made payable within 15 years on the installment plan and shall be a charge against all rateable property in the City of North Bay.
- This by-law shall not become effective until approval has been received from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 347, Section 64(1).
