

BY-LAW NO. 1138

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1002 relating to the establishment and maintenance of a Department of Industry pursuant to Section 411 Sub-Section 1, Chapter 233, Revised Statutes of Ontario 1927 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend By-Law No. 1002 in relation to the establishment and maintenance of a Department of Industry.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT Clauses 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10 and 11 of By-Law No. 1002 be, and are hereby rescinded and the following inserted in lieu thereof:

1. That a Commission to be known as the Industrial Commission of the City of North Bay be established for the City of North Bay.

2. That the said Commission shall be composed of

- R. H. THOMSON
- JAS. McILVENNA

3. The members of the said Commission shall hold office for life or until removed by the Council.

4. The Commission shall elect a Chairman who shall preside at all meetings of the Commission.

5. Two of the members of the Commission present at any meeting shall constitute a quorum thereof.

6. The said members of the Commission shall serve without remuneration.

7. THIS BY-LAW shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
