

BY-LAW NO. 1778...

BEING A BY-LAW of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for the revision of Salaries in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS IT IS DEEMED ADVISABLE that the Salaries of Aldermen of the City of North Bay be revised.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 243 SEC. 417 (1c) AND SECTION 419A AS AMENDED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Each duly elected Alderman of the City of North Bay be paid at the rate of \$12.00 per meeting for each Regular Council and Committee Meeting.
2. That of such payment \$8.00 is to be considered as Salary and \$4.00 is to be considered as out of pocket expenses incidental to the fulfillment of the position of Alderman.
3. That this By-Law shall come into full force and effect on the first day of January 1956 and all other by-laws inconsistent with this by-law be hereby repealed.
