THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2321

A by-law to authorize the erection of public telephone booths upon the highways or lands of the Corporation and to authorize the execution of an agreement with The Bell Telephone Company of Canada for that purpose.

WHEREAS Paragraph 104 of Sub-section (1) of Section 379 of The Municipal Act R.S.O. 1960 Chapter 249 provides that by-laws may be passed by the councils of local municipalities for authorizing the erection of public telephone booths upon the highways or lands of the municipality upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Public telephone booths may be erected from time to time or at any time hereafter by The Bell Telephone Company of Canada upon the highways or lands of the Corporation at the locations mentioned in the agreement referred to in paragraph 2 hereof and at such other location or locations as may from time to time be approved by resolution of the Council, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the said agreement.
- 2. The Mayor and the Clerk of the Corporation are hereby empowered and authorized to execute on behalf of the Corporation under its Corporate seal an agreement between the Corporation and The Bell Telephone Company of Canada, which has been read at the present meeting, authorizing the said Company to construct, erect and maintain public telephone booths upon parts of the highways of the Corporation and upon other lands of the Corporation upon the terms and conditions set forth in the said agreement.
- 3. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon and after the passing thereof.
