

BEING a By-law providing for the keeping, storing and transporting of gasoline within the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to pass a By-law for keeping, storing and transporting of gasoline within the Corporation of the City of North Bay .

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :-

(1) That on or after the date of the passing of this By-law no new gasoline tank, gasoline pump or connections therewith shall be erected on any street in the City of North Bay.

(2) That any person already having secured the right to construct a gasoline tank or gasoline pump and pipes connected therewith shall hold such right only at the will and pleasure of the municipality , and shall move same off the highways and streets of the municipality or such other place as the Council shall direct on receiving one week's notice and shall be entitled to refund for any portion of the year for which said gasoline tank, gasoline pump or pipes connected therewith have not been used, but shall have no other claim against the municipality.

(3) Any gasoline tank, gasoline pump and pipes already installed with the consent of the Council at any place designated by the City Engineer shall not be moved without the written permission of the City Engineer, and on said removal the permission granted by the said Council for the use of the space occupied by the said gasoline tank, gasoline pump or pipes shall automatically be rescinded, and the owner or lessee shall not be entitled to receive a new permit to erect or substitute a gasoline tank, gasoline pump or pipes on any street within the said city.

(4) No gasoline tank, gasoline pump or pipes connected therewith shall be installed on private property in the City of North Bay without first obtaining the approval of the city council and of the City Engineer and the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of North Bay for which a fee of \$5.00 each per year shall be charged.

(5) That the fee for any single gasoline tank and pipes connected therewith shall be \$25.00 , per year.

(6) That the fee for any single gasoline pump and pipes connected therewith shall be \$25.00 , per year

(7) The fee for each double gasoline tank shall be \$50.00 per year and the fee for a gasoline pump and pipes connected therewith shall be \$50.00 per year.

(8) That any person convicted of a breach of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each offence, exclusive of costs, and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith, the said penalty and costs or costs only may be levied by distress and the sale of the goods and chattels of the offender, and in case of there being no distress found out of which said penalty can be recovered the convicting magistrate may commit the offender to the common gaol in the City of North Bay, with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding six months unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.

(9) By-law number Seven Hundred and Eighty-one (781) is hereby repealed.

(10) This By-law shall come into effect immediately on the passing thereof.
