

BY-LAW NO. 1185

BEING A BY-LAW to appoint a Solicitor for the City of North Bay and for repealing By-Law No. 1131 which provided for the appointment of Wm. M. Flannery for the year 1934.

WHEREAS it is Necessary to repeal By-Law No. 1131 covering the appointment of a Solicitor for the year 1934.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary that the Corporation of The City of North Bay appoint a Solicitor for the said City and fix remuneration for such services.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Wm. M. Flannery be appointed Solicitor for the said Corporation of the City of North Bay.

2. THAT Wm. M. Flannery so appointed, shall receive as remuneration, quarterly the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per annum.

3. THAT the term of his engagement may be terminated at any time at the pleasure of this Council without any notice being required to that effect.

3A. THAT the duties of the City Solicitor shall include any and all the legal work of the Corporation of the City of North Bay and there shall be no further fee whatever for legal services of any kind.
