BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend By-law No. 2066, a by-law to authorize a Municipal Employees retirement scheme under the provisions of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Scheme.

AND WHEREAS it is considered essential to meet the request of the employees of the North Bay Fire Fighters' Association to provide a normal retirement at the age of 60 of all employees of the North Bay Fire Department.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That Clause 4 of By-law No. 2066 be amended by deleting the age figure of 65 years relating to Firemen in line 5 and inserting the age figure of 60 years in lieu thereof 1. so that the Clause shall now read -

CLAUSE 4

DEPUTY

The Treasurer shall file a certificate with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board to the effect that employees who are policemen are entitled to retire at age 65 and firemen are entitled to retire at age 60 years.

That the effective date shall be the 1st day of January, 2. 1963 and upon final passing thereof.
