

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAYBY-LAW NO. 91-69

BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING BY-LAW NO. 396A OF THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF WEST FERRIS AND CONFIRMING THE APPLICATION OF BY-LAW NO. 2332 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO THE WHOLE AREA OF THE CITY AS PRESENTLY ESTABLISHED AND SUCH AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED FROM TIME TO TIME.

WHEREAS By-law No. 2332 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay sets out certain requirements relating to itinerant sellers of goods, wares or merchandise and provides for the licensing thereof;

AND WHEREAS By-law No. 396A of the former Township of West Ferris contains requirements and provisions of like nature;

AND WHEREAS it is considered advisable to repeal said By-law No. 396A of the former Township of West Ferris and to confirm the application of By-law No. 2332 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay to the whole area of the City as presently established and such as may be established from time to time.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of North Bay is empowered to repeal the said By-law No. 396A by virtue of an Order of The Ontario Municipal Board dated November 23rd, 1967.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law No. 396A of the former Township of West Ferris is repealed.
2. By-law No. 2332 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall apply to the whole area of the City as presently established and such as may be established from time to time and all other by-laws or parts of by-laws of the said Corporation, of the former Township of West Ferris, and of the former Township of Widdifield, in conflict with the terms and conditions of said By-law No. 2332 shall be deemed to be and are hereby repealed.
