BY-LAW NO. 1799

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to amend By-Law No. 1438, a By-law providing for the cleaning of the streets and the collection of waste.

- 3. That the Schedule of rates referred to in Schedule
 "A" of this By-law shall become effective from the
 lst day of January 1956.
- 4. That all By-laws of the City of North Bay inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law are hereby repealed.
