A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to amend By-law 2146, a by-law to provide for the establishment of a policy of an award to resident students of North Bay who bring high honour to the City by being named "Ontario Scholar" by the Department of Education of Ontario.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend said By-law 2146 to provide for the honouring of non-resident students upon graduation from the several secondary schools of the City of North Bay by the presentation of certificates of award as set out in said By-law 2146.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Clause No. 3 of By-law 2146 be amended by striking out, in line one, the words "and such certificates" immediately following the word "keys" and inserting in the third line immediately following the words "resident students" and preceding the words "of the North Bay Secondary Schools" the words "and said certificates shall be for the use of both resident and non-resident students" so that Clause No. 3 shall now read:-

> "THAT the use of such keys is hereby reserved exclusively as an award for academic achievement by resident students and said certificates shall be for the use of both resident and nonresident students of the North Bay Secondary Schools who have been named "Ontario Scholar" by the Department of Education of Ontario."

2. That this by-law shall include all students who in the past, present and future who have been and shall be named "Ontario Scholar" as aforesaid.
