

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.**

**BY-LAW NO. 2001-73**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND PARKS BY-LAW  
NO. 35-96 REGARDING USE OF SKATEBOARDS  
AND IN-LINE SKATES AT THE WATERFRONT**

WHEREAS Section 207(58) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. **M-45**, as amended, provides that by-laws may be passed for maintaining, operating and managing parks, recreational areas and playgrounds within a municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of North Bay deems it desirable to restrict skateboards, in-line skates, scooters and bicycles from parts of the Waterfront;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS **AS** FOLLOWS:

1. North Bay Parks By-Law No. 35-96 is hereby amended in the following manner:
  - (a) Section 19 is hereby renumbered to Section 19(1)
  - (b) Section 61 regarding pathways is hereby renumbered to Section 19(3).
  - (c) Section 1(o) is hereby amended to delete the definition of “non-motorized vehicle/muscular powered vehicle” and to insert in lieu thereof the following:

“Prohibited Vehicle” means a skateboard, in-line skates, bicycle or a scooter, but does not include any type of vehicle used as a wheelchair.

2. North Bay Parks By-Law No. 35-96 is hereby amended to add the following:

“19(2)(a) Where authorized signs are on display, no person shall operate a prohibited vehicle:

1. Between Memorial Drive and Lake Nipissing within the following areas:

Beginning at the intersection of Memorial Drive and the road access to the Government Dock;

Thence easterly along Memorial Drive to Stanley Street;

Thence northerly to the shoreline of Lake Nipissing;

Thence westerly along the shoreline of Lake Nipissing to the Government Dock;

Thence southerly along the Government Dock to Memorial Drive.

2. in Memorial Park.


19(2)(b) Section 19(2)(a) does not apply to persons who are walking their bicycle or carrying their Skateboard, in-line skates or scooter.”

3. This By-Law comes into force upon being passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2001.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2001.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 9TH DAY OF JULY, 2001.
