THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 31-79

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2100 BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE ADOPTION OF CERTAIN POLICY MATTERS.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay considers it advisable to amend By-law No. 2100 to establish a policy for construction of new sidewalks in the City of North Bay.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 17(a)(iv) of By-law No. 2100 be amended to read as follows:

> "17(a)(iv) That construction of new sidewalks be financed from the current budget, such construction to be forecasted several years in advance but to be approved annually by Council following notification to affected property owners and such construction to be based on current Institute of Traffic Engineers criteria which, inter alia, relate the need for sidewalks to the volume of pedestrian traffic and the volume and speed of vehicular traffic."

2. This By-law shall take effect upon the final passing thereof.
