

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 171-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 146-70
AS TO REPAIRS OF BROKEN WATERLINES.

WHEREAS Section 27 of the Public Utilities Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 423, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws for the maintenance of waterworks and for the charges to meet the cost of any service done for the supply of water.

AND WHEREAS it is considered advisable to establish the curb stop of a waterline as the boundary for determining the cost of repairs to broken waterlines.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The second paragraph of section 2 (a) of By-law No. 146-70 is hereby amended by adding to the beginning thereof: "...subject to the sixth paragraph of section 2 (a) hereof,".
2. Section 2 (a) of By-law No. 146-70 is hereby amended by adding a sixth paragraph to section 2 (a) thereof as follows:

"In the event that an existing water service line is broken, the Corporation will determine the location of the broken water service line and one of the following procedures will apply:


- (A) Service line broken on owner's side of the curbs stop: The owner will make private arrangements to have the service line repaired or shall sign a prescribed contract to authorize the City to repair the service, on condition that all risk associated with such repairs as well as the cost thereof shall be borne by the owner. If the curb stop is located across the travelled portion of a highway from an owner, then the City shall bear the cost of any repair work under such travelled portion of the highway.
- (B) Service line broken on city side of the curb stop-the City shall repair the service line at its own expense.


3. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon being finally passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 20th DAY OF SEPTEMBER , 1982.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 4th DAY OF OCTOBER , 1982.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 4th DAY OF OCTOBER , 1982.
