BY-LAW NO. 37-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW  
NO. 57-89 SECTION 24B (SCHEDULE 20 -  
LOADING ZONES - RESTRICTED TIMES)

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-Laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-Laws regulating traffic on highways.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Traffic By-Law No. 57-89 be amended by adding the following Section 24B to provide for Loading Zones with Restricted Times.

LOADING ZONES - RESTRICTED TIMES - SCHEDULE 20

- 24B. (1) In this section "Commercial Motor Vehicles" means a motor vehicle which is identified by a sign painted on or firmly attached to the outside of the vehicle, which bears the name or style of the business and which vehicle is used for the purpose of delivery of materials.
- (2) Loading zones with restricted times are hereby established on those portions of the highway set out in Schedule 20 of this by-law.
  - (3) No person shall park or stand a vehicle other than a commercial motor vehicle or taxi in a loading zone with restricted times.
  - (4) No person shall park a commercial motor vehicle in a loading zone with restricted times except while activity engaged in loading or unloading materials.
  - (5) No person shall park a commercial motor vehicle in a loading zone with restricted times for more than twenty (20) minutes.
  - (6) No driver of a vehicle shall stand a vehicle perpendicular to the curb except:
    - (a) when loading or unloading materials, and
    - (b) the vehicle is a semi-trailer or trailer combination whereby the motor vehicle or truck tractor unit thereof stands parallel to the curb and faced in the direction of going traffic, and
    - (c) the vehicle does not interfere with or interrupt the passage of traffic.
  - (7) No person shall transfer merchandise or materials of any kind from a commercial motor vehicle to another vehicle on any street except in the event of mechanical failure or breakdown.
