BY-LAW NO. 2017

WHEREAS North Bay Branch 23 of the Royal Canadian Legion has undertaken a building project to provide housing for elderly citizens in the City of North Bay and such project requires water and sewage works and xaxsaxvive xroad to be brought to such project.

AND WHEREAS by Resolution passed by a three-fourths vote of all of its members, this Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to provide such water and sewage works and sexual and seven and sewage works.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (i) an 8" sanitary sewer from Cassells Street southerly a distance of 367 lineal feet,
- (ii) a 6" watermain to interconnect existing watermains on Cassells Street and Fraser Street,
- (iii) axservicexroadxfromx&assellex&treetxsoutherlyxtoxax
 pointxadjacentxtoxthexsitexofxthex&lderlyx&tizensx
 HousingxProjectxofxNorthxBayxBranchx&x&xacatan
 Legion;
- 2. THAT said works shall be undertaken as a Public Utility undertaking under authority of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1960, Chap. 249, Sec. 379(1)52.
- 3. THAT the Engineering Department of the City of North Bay be instructed to make all necessary plans, profiles and specifications forthwith, and to furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work, or for the carrying on of the work by day labour.
- 4. THAT the work shall be carried on under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of the Engineering Department of the City of North Bay.
- 5. THAT the council may decide by resolution to carry on and execute the work by day labour.
- 6. THAT in the absence of a resolution by Council that the work be carried on and executed by day labour, the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with some person or persons, firm or Corporation for the construction of the work, subject to the approval of the Council by resolution.
- 7. THAT for the purpose aforesaid the Corporation may borrow by way of Promissory Note from the Royal Bank of Canada a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).
- 8. THAT in payment of the loan authorized by Clause No. 7 aforementioned the Corporation shall prior to June 1st in each of the years 1963 and 1964 pay to the Royal Bank of Canada a sum up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) or such lesser amount as was necessary to borrow for the purpose.


