BY-LAW NUMBER 622

1) Constant Const

BEING a By-law to provide for the payment of Councillors in the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, as amended 1920, Chapter 58, Section 19, permits Councils of Towns and Villages to pay members of the Council for their attendance at meetings of the Council, at a rate not exceeding Five Dollars, (\$5.00) a day,

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay deems it advisable to pass a By-law for such payments,

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, enacts as follows:

1. That the members of the Council of the Town of North Bay be paid for their attendance at meetings of the Council at a rate not exceeding Five Dollars (\$5.00) a day.

2. That this By-law shall be effective as of date of January 1st., 1921.

READ in open Council a first time, June 6th., 1921. Read in open Council a second time, June 20th., 1921. PASSED in open Council, this 20th day of June, 1921.
