BEING A BY-LAW to appoint a Solicitor for the City of North Bay and for repealing By-Law Number 1185 which provided for the appointment of a Solicitor for the year 1935.

WHEREAS it is necessary that the Corporation of the City of North Bay appoint a Solicitor for the said Corporation and fix remuneration for such services.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT By-Law Number 1185 be and the same is hereby repealed.

2. THAT H. J. Reynolds, K.C. be appointed Solicitor for the said Corporation of the City of North Bay.

3. THAT H. J. Reynolds, K.C. so appointed shall receive as remuneration the sum of EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$800.00) per annum payable TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) quarterly.

4. THAT the duties of the City Solicitor so appointed shall include any and all the legal work of the Corporation of the City of North Bay and there shall be no further fee chargeable to the Corporation.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third Time short and passed this 6th. day of April, 1936.
