BY-LAW NO. 2003-165

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1-93,
BEING A BY-LAW FORMULATING A PLAN FOR
PROTECTING PROPERTY AND THE HEALTH,
SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS
OF AN EMERGENCY AREA

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has passed the *Emergency Management Act*, which requires municipalities to develop an Emergency Management Program at the Essential Level;

AND WHEREAS Council passed Resolution No. 2003-193 at its Regular Meeting on April 7, 2003 to amend By-law No. 1-93 to adopt the requirements of the *Emergency Management Act*;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Section 1 of By-law No. 1-93 shall be amended to include the following:
 - (b) The Community Emergency Response Plan, as approved by Council, shall be published and copies are to made available to the public through the Office of the City Clerk.
 - (c) The Community Emergency Response Plan to include the following:
 - (i) identification of appropriate Emergency Operations Centre and suitable backup;
 - (ii) identification of critical infrastructure;
 - (iii) identification of an appropriate community emergency response capability; and
 - (iv) identification of individuals to act as Community Emergency Information Staff."
2. By-law No. 1-93 be amended to include the following:
 - "5. (a) The Fire Chief for The Corporation of the City of North Bay be named the "Community Emergency Management Coordinator for the City of North Bay".
 - (b) The extended Emergency Operations Control Group shall be named the "Community Emergency Management Program Committee".
3. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon being passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2003.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2003.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2003.
