BY-LAW NO. 2003-165

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1-93, BEING A BY-LAW FORMULATING A PLAN FOR PROTECTING PROPERTY AND THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS OF AN EMERGENCY AREA

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has passed the Emergency Management Act, which requires municipalities to develop an Emergency Management Program at the Essential Level:

AND WHEREAS Council passed Resolution No. 2003-193 at its Regular Meeting on April 7, 2003 to amend By-law No. 1-93 to adopt the requirements of the Emergency Management Act:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 1 of By-law No. 1-93 shall be amended to include the following:
 - The Community Emergency Response Plan, as approved by Council, shall be published and copies are to made available to the public through the Office of the City Clerk.
 - The Community Emergency Response Plan to include the following: (c)
 - identification of appropriate Emergency Operations Centre and suitable backup;
 - (ii) identification of critical infrastructure:
 - identification of an appropriate community emergency response (iii)
 - identification of individuals to act as Community Emergency (iv) Information Staff."
- By-law No. 1-93 be amended to include the following: 2.
 - "5. The Fire Chief for The Corporation of the City of North Bay be (a) named the "Community Emergency Management Coordinator for the City of North Bay".
 - The extended Emergency Operations Control Group shall be (b) named the "Community Emergency Management Program Committee".
- 3. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon being passed.
