

BY-LAW NUMBER 586.

BEING a By-law to fix the Polling-Places, appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the holding of Municipal and Public School Trustees' Elections for the year 1920.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-law fixing Polling Places and appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors to select a Mayor and nine Councillors to transact the Municipal affairs of the Town, for the election of Public School Trustees, and also for the passing of the several By-laws herein mentioned, namely:

- \$20,000.00 for acquiring land within the Municipality for Exhibition purposes.
- \$10,000.00 for acquiring land within the Municipality for Public Parks' purposes.
- \$ 5,000.00 for acquiring land and premises within the Municipality for the purposes of the Corporation.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows:-

4. That Polling Place No.4, for the purposes of the said election shall be in A.O. Laing's Store, corner McIntyre & Cassells Sts., and A.O. Laing is hereby appointed D.R.O., and W. M. Flannery, Poll Clerk.
5. That Polling Place No.5, for the purposes of the said election shall be in the Town Hall, and A. C. Amos is hereby appointed D.R.O., and Harry L. Small, Poll Clerk.
6. That Polling Place no.6, for the purposes of the said election shall be in A. Smith's Shop, 66 McIntyre St.E., and N. Phelps is hereby appointed D.R.O. and ~~Alex. Smith~~ <sup>Whitney Brown</sup>, Poll Clerk.
7. That Polling Place No.7, for the purposes of the said election shall be in the Orange Hall, and G.H. Newton is hereby appointed D.R.O., and ~~J. W. Sewell~~ <sup>B. Parkhouse</sup>, Poll Clerk.

10. That Polling Place No. 10, for the purposes of the said election shall be in Ambrose Grieve's House, 178 Fisher St., and J.A. Lehman is hereby appointed D.R.O., and Roy Herbert, Poll Clerk.

11. That Polling Place No.11, for the purposes of the said election shall be in J.P. Quinlan's Office, Percy St., and Geo. W. Deegan is hereby appointed D.R.O., and G.L. Riches, Poll Clerk.

12. That Polling Place No.12, for the purposes of the said election shall be in A. Chirico's Store, Front St. & Third Ave., and C.S. McGaughey is hereby appointed D.R.O., and <sup>Reg. White</sup> ~~Simon Dunn~~, Poll Clerk.

13. That Polling Place No.13, for the purposes of the said election shall be in E. C. Rebee's Store, Cassells & Third Sts., and D. J. McKeown is hereby appointed D.R.O., and E.C.Rebee, Poll Clerk.
