## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 132-89

A BY-LAW TO REQUIRE REMOVAL OF DERELICT VEHICLES FROM PARCEL 14782 W & F.

WHEREAS section 210 (74) of the Municipal Act authorizes council to pass by-laws to require the clearing of any grounds, yard and vacant lots;

AND WHEREAS an Order to Sherry's Store Ltd., as owner, to clear Parcel 14782 W & F in the City of North Bay made on April 12, 1989, pursuant to section 6 of By-law 97-68 has not been complied with to date;

AND WHEREAS section 325 of the Municipal Act enables the Council to direct that in default of compliance with the Order, the vehicles referred to therein may be removed from the said property at the expense of the owner and such expense recovered in like manner as municipal taxes;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to have the said lands cleared;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law is being sent by ordinary mail and by registered mail to the owner of Parcel 14782 W & F.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The Pollution Control Officer for the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to remove any vehicles which are in a state of disrepair from the lands known as Parcel 14782 in the Register for Widdifield and Ferris in the Land Titles Division of Nipissing in the City of North Bay at the expense of the owner of the said lands.
- 2. The expense incurred pursuant to section 1 hereof shall be recovered by action or in like manner as municipal taxes upon delivery of a statement of the Pollution Control Officer of the actual cost of removing the said vehicles from the said lands to the Tax Collector for the City of North Bay, who shall enter the amount on the Collector's Roll for the said property, such amount to be a lien on the said lands until paid.
- 3. The Pollution Control Officer is authorized to enter upon the said lands with such workers and equipment as is required by him and to remove the said vehicles to a licensed scrap yard, there to be stored for sixty (60) days and thereafter to be disposed of according to law.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 24TH DAY OF JULY , 1989. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 8TH DAY OF AUGUST , 1989. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 8TH DAY OF AUGUST , 1989.
