THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2210

Being a by-law to expropriate the lands and premises hereinafter described and known as Municipal No. 655 Stanley Street in the City of North Bay

WHEREAS the lands and premises hereinafter described are situate in a low lying area.

AND WHEREAS the building on the said lands is in a dilapidated state.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Corporation of the Ci of North Bay do acquire the aforesaid lands and premises for use as a park or playground or for such other purposes as the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay, from time to time, may decide.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF HORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following lands and premises, namely:

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing and Frovince of Ontario and being composed of Lot No. Five (5) and the southerly Seven (7) Feet from front to rear of Lot No. Four (4) on the south-westerly side of Stanley Street as shown on Plan No. 95 for the City of North Bay, registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing;

are hereby expropriated and taken for or in connection with the purposes hereinbefore recited.

That an agreement be entered into with Alma Fournier of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing, widow, for the amount of compensation to be paid for the above described lands and premises not exceeding Four Thousand (\$4,000.) Dollars and that the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute the said agreement on behalf of the Corporation.
