 By-Law 536

BEING a By-law to provide for the payment of Poll Tax by residents of the Town of North Bay and the collection of the same.


WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Statute Labour Act" R.S.O. Chapter 196, Section 4, and amendments thereto, Municipal Councils are authorized to pass a By-law to levy a tax on every male inhabitant of a Town, twenty-one years and upwards, and under sixty years of age, who are not other wise assessed upon the Assessment Roll of the Municipality, at a yearly rate of not more than Five Dollars and to provide for the collection of said tax.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay to pass such a By-law.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ENACTED BY THE Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, as follows;-

1. That every male inhabitant of the Town of North Bay of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, and under sixty years of age, who has not been otherwise assessed on the Assessment Roll of the said Town shall pay a yearly tax of Five Dollars to the Town of North Bay, which said tax shall be levied and collected by the Chief of Police, who is hereby appointed Poll Tax Collector, and authorized to levy and collect the said Tax.
2. That all other By-laws of the said Town with reference to the payment of and collection of Poll Tax in the said Municipality, are hereby repealed.
3. That this By-law shall take effect immediately on the passing thereof.
