BY-LAW NO. 173-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND SELL AN ORIGINAL LAKESHORE ROAD ALLOWANCE ALONG TROUT LAKE. (DUGAS BAY)

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it desirable to close up and sell part of an original Lakeshore Road allowance along the shores of Dugas Bay on Trout Lake;

AND WHEREAS Section 298 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws to stop up and sell the freehold of a highway, provided that the by-law does not take effect until it has been approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law has been published at least once a week for four successive weeks and the Council has heard any person who claims that his land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who has applied to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That certain part of a highway being the original Lakeshore Road allowance along the shores of Dugas Bay on Trout Lake designated as Part 2 according to a Reference Plan prepared by P.A. Blackburn, O.L.S. dated December 21, 1983 is hereby stopped up and closed.
- 2. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to sell the soil and freehold of that part of the said original lakeshore road allowance designated as Part 2 on the said reference plan to R. Young, registered owner of Parcel 1816 W & F.
- 3. That certain part of a highway being the original lakeshore road allowance being 100 feet in width abutting Part of Lot 26, Concession 17, Parcel 4348 W & F be stopped up and closed.
- 4. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to sell the soil and freehold of that part of the original lakeshore road allowance being 100 feet in width abutting part of Lot 26, Concession 17, Parcel 4348 W & F to John and Eileen Walkom, registered owner of Parcel 4348 W & F.
- 5. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a transfer in favour of the registered owner of land as referred to in Sections 2 and 4 of this by-law.
- 6. This by-law does not take effect until it has been approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 29TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1986. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 8TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1986. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 8TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1986.
