Your Worship and Councillors:

The Engineering & Works Committee presents Report No. 2004-12 and recommends:

- 1. That a) North Bay City Council approve a contract be awarded to Ran Don Crane and Leasing Ltd., in the amount of \$1,269,423.05 (GST inc.) for the completion of Earthworks and Engineered Controls at the Merrick Landfill Site;
  - b) approval be granted to complete the 2004 Merrick Landfill Capital Works Program at a total cost of \$2,300,000.00 bringing the total project cost up to \$4,300,000.00;
  - c) approval be granted to transfer \$250,000.00 from the Merrick Landfill Reserve Account to fund a portion of the 2004 Capital Works Program to manage leachate at the Merrick Landfill Site;
  - d) approval be granted to debenture an additional \$750,000.00 to complete the 2004 Capital Works Program to manage leachate at the Merrick Landfill Site and that the Capital By-Law be presented for City Council approval; and
  - e) approval be granted to extend the existing design contract currently awarded to Conestoga Rovers and Associates to carry out a Quality Assurance/Quality Control Program during the construction contract to produce verification documentation in fulfillment of Conditions of Approval imposed by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment.
