BY-LAW NO. 2002-099

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND PROCEDURAL
BY-LAW NO. 2000-66

WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2002-436 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting on Monday, July 22, 2002, Council approved the amendment of the Procedural By-law so as to move the consideration of by-laws after correspondence, to identify Proclamations as a matter for the beginning of the meeting and to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute Subdivision and Pre-Servicing Agreements which have been approved by Resolution of Council, and which are in the form recently approved by Council, where subdivision services are provided to the satisfaction of the CAO on the recommendation of City Engineer, the Managing Director of Community Services and the City Solicitor.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 39 of By-law No. 2000-66 is deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof

“39. The Clerk shall prepare for the use of the members an Agenda as follows:


- 1) Roll Call
- 2) Proclamations
- 3) Public Presentations
- 4) Minutes
- 5) Declarations of Conflict of Interest
- 6) Reports of Standing Committees
- 7) Correspondence
- 8) Motions and Motions for Reconsideration
- 9) By-laws
- 10) Questions and Inquiries
- 11) Giving Notice
- 12) Supplementary Correspondence
- 13) Motion to Adjourn.”

2. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon being passed.
