

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 112-90

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW  
NO. 57-89 (SCHEDULE 2 - NO PARKING  
ANY TIME).

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-Laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 198, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-Laws regulating traffic on highways.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule 2 to Traffic By-Law No. 57-89 is hereby amended by adding the following:

Section B

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
6. Bloem Street	South	80 metres west of Algonquin Avenue westerly to Browning Street

Section M


<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
21. McLaren Street	South	Algonquin Avenue and Durril Street


2. That Section 35(2) be amended by deleting the reference to Sections 13(2) and 22 from the Clause.
3. That the following Section 35(7) be added to By-Law No. 57-89:  
35(7) "Any person who contravenes any provision of Section 13(2) and Section 22 is guilty of an offence and is liable to a penalty of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$50.00 exclusive of costs and such penalty shall be recovered under the Summary Convictions Act or the Provincial Offences Act, whichever is applicable."

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25TH DAY OF JUNE, 1990.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9th DAY OF July 1990.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 9th DAY OF July, 1990.
