BY-LAW NO. 96-85

A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN AGREEMENT REGARDING A
PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY.

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to construct a pedestrian walkway in order to develop the Lake Nipissing Waterfront.

AND WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has agreed to assist with the capital cost of construction of the pedestrian walkway.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement dated June 25th 1985, with Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Natural Resources regarding a contribution of Three Hundred and Sixty Thousand Dollars towards the cost of a pedestrian walkway along the shore of Lake Nipissing.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the said Agreement and to apply thereto the corporate seal.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.
