BY-LAW NO. 158-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE AND STOP UP PART
OF A HIGHWAY NO LONGER USED FOR TRAVEL
KNOWN AS OLD PENINSULA ROAD

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it desirable to close and stop up that Highway known as Part of Old Peninsula Road and designated as Part 2 according to Reference Plan 36R-5879;

AND WHEREAS Notice of this proposed by-law was published for four successive weeks and the Council or a Committee of Council has heard in person any person or his representative who claims to be prejudicially affected and who applies to be heard pursuant to section 301 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302;

AND WHEREAS the said lands are no longer required for public travel due to the alignment of Peninsula Road


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That Highway designated as Part 2, according to Reference Plan 36R-5879, being Part of Parcel 163 in the Register for Widdifield and Ferris in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed and upon a certified copy of this by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9th DAY OF August , 1982.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 7th DAY OF September, 1982.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 7th DAY OF September , 1982.
