

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 19-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 20-72  
RESPECTING MOTORIZED SNOW VEHICLES

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend certain regulations respecting the use of motcrized snow vehicles within the City of North Bay pursuant to section 6 of The Motorized Snow Vehicles Act.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule "B" of By-law No. 20-72 be deleted and the attached Schedule be inserted as Schedule "B" of By-law No. 20-72 in lieu thereof.

2. That Subsection (c) of Section 4 of By-law No. 20-72 be deleted and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

"4. (c) No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle within the area outlined in Schedule "B" attached hereto unless such motorized snow vehicle is being operated for the purpose of moving it by the most direct route between the place where it is normally kept and an area where the operation of motorized snow vehicles is permitted; provided that nothing in this subsection shall be deemed to permit the operation of a motorized snow vehicle on a highway".

3. Section 9 of By-law No. 20-72 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:

"9. No provision of this By-law shall become operative as to the highways designated as connecting links pursuant to subsection 1 of Section 19 of The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act and as set out on Schedule "C" attached hereto until approval of this By-law by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications."


4. This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25th DAY OF May , 1981.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 8th DAY OF June , 1981.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED
