BY-LAW NO. 1656

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for the Revision of Salaries in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that the Salaries of the Aldermen of the City of North Bay be revised.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 243 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ONTARIO AND AMENDMENTS THERETO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT each duly elected Alderman of the City of North Bay shall be paid the annual remuneration of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) which said sum shall be payable quarterly. Provided however that there shall be a deduction of Seven Dollars (\$7.00) from each Alderman for each meeting of Council not attended by him and a further deduction of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each Committee Meeting not attended.
- 2. THAT By-law No. 1647 and all other By-laws inconsistent with this By-law are hereby repealed.
- 3. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect on the first day of January 1952.
