BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 27-83
BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 144-77
BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE AN IMPROVEMENT
AREA TO BE KNOWN AS THE DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT
AREA AND TO ESTABLISH A BOARD OF MANAGEMENT
THEREFORE

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to repeal By-law No. 27-83 and to amend the method of appointment to the Board of the Downtown Improvement Area;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- established pursuant to Section 2 of By-law No. 144-77
 shall consist of nine (9) members, two of whom shall be
 Members of Council and the other members shall be
 appointed from among those recommended by the
 Progressive Business Guild and from such members of
 the Downtown Improvement Area as apply for appointment.
- That the persons so appointed to the Board of Management of the Downtown Improvement Area shall be persons qualified to be elected as members of the Council, assessed for business assessment in respect of land in the area or nominees of Corporations so assessed, provided that such nominees are persons qualified to be elected as members of the Council.
- 3. By-law No. 27-83 is hereby repealed.
- 4. This by-law shall come into effect as of 9 December 1985.
