

BY-LAW NO. 1051

BEING A BY-LAW authorizing the spreading of Tar or of a Binder on the crushed rock streets of the City of North Bay under the Provisions of the Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of North Bay deem it expedient to make provisions for the spreading of Tar or of a Binder on the crushed rock streets of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT Tar or a Binder be spread on the crushed rock streets of the City of North Bay where such work is requested by properly signed petitions under the Local Improvement Act.
2. THAT the cost of such work should be charged one hundred per cent. against the property directly abutting on the work with the exception that the City are to pay for the cost of the intersections work.
3. THAT the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute contracts for the construction of the work required under a properly executed petition and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of the Council to be declared by resolution.
4. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence of and in accordance with the directions and orders of the City Engineer.
5. THAT the Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council agree with any bank or person for temporary advance of money to meet the cost of the work pending completion of it.
6. THAT the Special Assessment shall be paid by five equal annual instalments.
7. THAT the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum and be payable within five years on the instalment plan.
8. THAT any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon by paying a portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk.


