

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 44-79

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 126-76 REGARDING THE LICENSING, REGULATING AND GOVERNING OF TOURIST CAMPS, TRAILER CAMPS AND MOTELS AND FOR DESIGNATING AREAS OF LANDS TO BE USED AS TOURIST CAMPS, TRAILER CAMPS OR MOTELS AND FOR PROHIBITING THE USE OF OTHER LAND FOR SUCH PURPOSES.

WHEREAS Section 354 (1) (86) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, c. 284, as amended, was repealed by The Municipal Amendment Act, S.O. 1976, Chapter 69, which repeal came into force on January 1, 1979;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to amend By-law No. 126-76 to reflect the deletion of Section 354 (1) (86) of The Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Sub-sections (g), (h) and (i) of Section 1 of By-law No. 126-76 are repealed.
2. Sub-section (j) of Section 1 of By-law No. 126-76 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(j) "Tourist Trailer" means any vehicle so constructed that it is suitable for being attached to a motor vehicle for the purpose of being drawn or propelled by the motor vehicle and capable of being used for the living, sleeping or eating accommodation of persons notwithstanding that such vehicle is jacked up or that its running gear is removed."
3. Section 2.8 of By-law No. 126-76 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:


"2.8 (a) No tourist trailer is permitted to be located in the City except in a trailer camp operated or licensed by the City without a licence therefor."

"2.8 (b) Section 2.8 (a) does not apply to a trailer located in the City only for the purpose of sale or storage."
4. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon being finally passed.
