BY-LAW No. 52-76

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF LAND

The Corporation of the City of North Bay (insert Council or Board) (insert name of Municipality or Board)

enacts that—

The land hereinafter particularly described, namely, All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being part of Lot 18 on the North side of Judge Avenue in the City of North Bay, as shown on a plan of a portion of said City by L.O. Clarke, C.L.S. and registered in the Registry Office on October 16th, 1906.

These parts further described as follows:

FIRSTLY: Part of Lot 18 - Commencing at the southwest angle of Lot 18; Thence East along Judge Avenue 40' to the Southeast angle of said lot; Thence North along the East boundary 75' to a point; Thence West and parallel to the south boundary 40' more or less to a point in the West boundary of said Lot 75' distant from the point of commencement; Thence along the West boundary 75' to the point of commencement.
