

BY-LAW NO. 1092

BEING A BY-LAW to appoint Collegiate Institute Trustees for the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-Law to provide for the appointment of Collegiate Institute Trustees for the City of North Bay to replace Messrs. S. B. Clement and R. A. Sheppard, whose terms of office expire on the 31st. day of December, 1932, and D. G. Stevens, who has resigned.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the following named persons be, and are, hereby appointed Collegiate Institute Trustees for the City of North Bay viz:


JAMES A. FALLON

S. B. CLEMENT


2. THAT JAMES A. FALLON and S. B. CLEMENT so appointed shall retire at the end of the year 1935, and be replaced by two others to be appointed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay, who shall hold office for a term of three years.

3. THAT R. A. SHEPPARD shall retire at the end of the year 1933, and be replaced by another to be appointed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay.

Hydrant rentals and all other Municipal services, with a guarantee of \$2,500.00, net remuneration per year.

6. That, in order to more equalize the monthly payments the Tax Collector and Water Commission be paid the sum of Two Hundred Dollars per month, and charged to his account with the balance of remuneration payable on Dec. 31st. of the year.

7. The Collector shall be paid an additional sum of Seventy-Five (\$75.00) dollars per month with which to pay an assistant suitable to and chosen by the Collector. He shall pay said assistant a minimum salary of \$75.00 per month. The assistant shall be acceptable to the Finance Committee, and be responsible to the Collector and the Collector responsible to the City for his office management, and in order to comply with the provisions of this By-Law and the Statutes with reference to the collection of Taxes and water rates.

8. That the City of North Bay shall furnish all necessary stationery and postage.


9. That the terms of engagement of the said Tax Collector and Water Commissioner may be terminated at any time at the pleasure of this Council, without any notice being required to that effect.

This By-Law shall be considered to take effect from the First day of January, 1933.
