

CITY OF NORTH BAY
BY LAW NO. 905

*Repealed by
Bylaw 968*

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of certain Water Mains and alterations to Water Works System, and the issue of Debentures for the sum of Two Hundred and Ninety-two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$292,950.00) for the purpose of making extensions and Alterations to the Water Works Distribution System in the City of North Bay pursuant to the report in writing, of the Provincial Board of Health.

WHEREAS the Provincial Board of Health on the *20th* day of *June*, 1929, reported in writing that having inquired into, ascertained and considered the existing conditions in the Municipality of the CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY,

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it is of the opinion that it is necessary in the interests of the Public Health that Extensions and Alterations of the Waterworks Distribution System be made on the following schedule:-

at a total estimated cost of Two Hundred and Ninety-two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$292,950.00) and it is incumbent on this Council to pass the necessary By/Law for the establishment of the works.

AND WHEREAS for the purpose aforesaid it is necessary to borrow on the credit of the Corporation at large, the said sum of Two Hundred and Ninety-two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$292,950.00) and to issue Debentures therefor, bearing interest at the rate of *4 1/2* per centum per annum, which is the amount of the debt intended to be created by this By/Law.

AND WHEREAS the source of supply and the proposed works have been approved by the Provincial Board of Health and such approval has been certified under the hand of the Chairman and Secretary of the said Board.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to make the said debt payable in 20 annual instalments during the period of 20 years, the currency of the debentures to be issued under this By/Law, of such amounts respectively that with the interest in respect of the debt payable annually, the aggregate amount payable for principal and interest in each year shall be as nearly as possible the same.

AND WHEREAS it will be necessary to raise in each year in which an instalment becomes due, the sum of \$22,521.27 to pay it when and as it becomes due.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the Municipality according to the last revised Assessment Roll is \$8,998,482.00 Eight Million, Nine Hundred and Ninety-eight Thousand, Four Hundred and Eighty-two Dollars,

AND WHEREAS the amount of the debenture debt of the Corporation, (exclusive of Local Improvement debts secured by special rates of assessment), is one Million, Three Hundred and Eleven Thousand, Seven Hundred and Forty-two Dollars and Fourteen Cents,-----and no part of the principal or interest thereof is in arrear,

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:

1. That extensions and alterations of the waterworks distribution system of the City of North Bay be made as per schedule mentioned in the preamble to this By/Law, in accordance with the Report in writing of the Provincial Board of Health hereinbefore referred to, and in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by the said Board.
2. For the purposed aforesaid there shall be borrowed on the credit of the Corporation at large, the sum of Two Hundred and Ninety-two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars, (\$292,950.00) and debentures shall be issued therefor in the sums of not less than One Hundred Dollars, (\$100⁰⁰), each.
3. The Debentures shall all bear the same date, and shall be issued within two years after the passing of the By-Law, and may bear any date within such two years, shall be payable in 20 equal annual instalments during the 20 years from the time when they are issued, and the respective amounts payable in each of such years shall be as set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto, which forms part of this By-Law.
4. The Debentures shall bear interest at the rate of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ % per centum per annum, payable annually, and shall have coupons attached thereto for the interest payable thereon in each year during the currency thereof and as to both principal and interest shall be expressed in Canadian Currency, and be made payable at the Royal Bank in North Bay, Ontario.
5. The Debentures shall be signed by the Mayor and by the Treasurer and shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation. The coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer and his signature to them may be written, stamped, lithographed or engraved.

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6. THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.

7. During the currency of the Debentures there shall be raised in each year in which an instalment of principal and interest becomes due, the sum of \$22,521.27 to pay it when and as it becomes due, as set forth in Schedule "B" to this By-Law.

8. THE Debentures may contain any clause providing for the registration of them authorized by law.

9. This By-Law shall take effect on the day of the final passing thereof, subject to tis being assented to by the Electors.

Read a first time in Open Council this 5th day of Nov. 1928

Read a second time in Open Council this 5th day of Nov. 1928 and ordered submitted to the Electors at the Municipal Elections December 3rd. 1928.

By-Law was assented to by Electors on December 3rd, 1928.

Read a third time and passed in Open Council this 29th day of December A. D. 1928.


