

BY-LAW NUMBER 897.

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law Number 837 relating to the salary to be paid to George A. Winton, as pound-keeper, the keeper of the dog pound, and market clerk, of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend By-law No. 837 in relation to the salary to be paid to George A. Winton, as pound-keeper, the keeper of the dog pound, and market clerk of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Clause No. 5 of By-law Number 837 be and is hereby rescinded and the following inserted in lieu thereof:-

(5) That the duties of the said George A. Winton shall be deemed to commence as of the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Twenty-seven, 1927, and he shall receive a monthly salary of One Hundred and Thirty-five Dollars (\$135.00) per month, same to become effective as from the First day of May, 1928.

Read a second time in Open Council this 17th day of September, 1928.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-law was read a third time short and passed this 17th day of September, 1928.
