

BY/LAW NUMBER 839

BEING a By/law to authorize the levying of a rate of taxation for the City of North Bay, to meet the requirements for the year 1927.

WHEREAS it is necessary that a sufficient amount of money be raised by taxation to meet the necessary expenses of the City of North Bay, for the year 1927.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY as follows:

1. <sup>19.9394</sup> THAT a rate of 25.0 mills on the Dollar for General Purposes be levied on all taxable property of the Municipality of the said City of North Bay as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1927 as finally revised and passed.

2. <sup>7.0606</sup> THAT a rate of 6.5 mills on the Dollar for Collegiate Institute Purposes be levied on all the taxable property for the Municipality for the said City of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1927, as finally revised and passed.

3. <sup>18</sup> THAT a rate of 17. mills on the Dollar for Public School Purposes be levied on all taxable property of the Public School Supporters in the Municipality of the said City of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1927, as finally revised and passed.

4. <sup>18</sup> THAT a rate of 17. mills on the Dollar for Separate School Purposes be levied on all taxable property of the Separate School Supporters in the Municipality of the said City of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1927, as finally revised and passed.

5. <sup>10</sup> THAT a rate of 3.5 mills on the Dollar for Debenture Purposes be levied on all taxable property of the Municipality for the said City of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1927, as finally revised and passed.

6. THAT a rate of 1. mill on the Dollar for the Home of the Aged Purposes be levied on all taxable property of the Municipality for the said City of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1927, as finally revised and passed. } *copy*
