

BY-LAW NUMBER 658

BEING a By-law for the borrowing of the sum of Twenty thousand dollars, (\$20,000.00) for the purpose of constructing storm sewers and improving high-ways within the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the purpose of constructing storm sewers and improving high-ways within the Town of North Bay, the sum of Twenty thousand dollars, and that is the amount of the debt intended to be created.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the Municipality according to the last revised assessment roll is \$6,507,808.00.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the debenture debt of the Corporation is \$1,045,164.95, no part of the principal or interest of which is in arrears.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay;-

1. For the purpose mentioned in the preamble there shall be borrowed on the credit of the Corporation the sum of Twenty thousand dollars, (\$20,000.00) and debentures shall be issued therefor, in sums of not less than \$100.00 each, which shall have coupons attached thereto for the payment of the interest.

2. The debentures shall all bear the same date and shall be issued within one year after the date on which this By-law is passed and may bear any date within such year and shall bear interest at the rate of five and one-half per cent per annum, payable yearly in ten annual instalments during the ten years next after the date when they shall be issued, and the respective amounts payable in each of such years shall be as follows;-

3. The Debentures as to both principal and interest may be expressed in Canadian Currency or in Sterling Money of Great Britain at the rate of one pound sterling for each four dollars and eighty-six and two-thirds cents, and shall be payable at the Royal Bank of Canada, North Bay, Ontario

4. The Debentures and the interest coupons shall be signed and issued by the Mayor, and shall be signed also by the Treasurer, and the debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation.

3. During the currency of the debentures there shall be raised in each year the amount of the instalment of principal and interest payable in that year as set forth in Section 2.

6. The Storm Sewers to be constructed and the Streets to be improved under this By-Law are set forth in Schedule "A" hereto attached.

7. The debentures may contain any provision for the registration of them authorized by law.

8. This by-law shall take effect on the day of the passing thereof, subject to its being assented to by the electors.

1. That the Third Reading of the above mentioned By-law was prematurely ordered by the Council of the Town of North Bay, by resolution No. 2, September 11th. 1922.

2. That said resolution No. 2 of September 11th. 1922 was rescinded by resolution No. 1 passed by the Council of the Town of North Bay, February 26th. 1923.

3. That the Ontario Railway and Municipal Board granted, on March 1st, 1923, an extension of time for the final passing of said By-law, pursuant to Sub-Section 5 of Section 200 of the Consolidated Municipal Act, said Order being numbered " P.F.8184.


