BEING A BY/LAW of the City of North Bay for dividing the City of North Bay into wards, and to provide for the number of aldermen to be elected in each Ward.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deem it expedient to divide the said City of North Bay into Wards as provided by the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section Forty-four (44) of the Consolidated Municipal Act, 1922, all the provisions have been duly carried out.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. The City of North Bay shall be divided into Five (5) Wards.



WARDS-- 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, of the City of North Bay.

SUMMARIES DESCRIPTIONS

Ward No. 1

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying West of Klock Avenue, North of Commerical Street, West of Third Avenue, South of Front Street and West of Douglas Street, and bounded as follows:-

On the South-West by Lake Nipissing from a point at the intersection where the centre line of Klock Avenue produced Southerly intersects the shores of Lake Nipissing thence in a North westerly direction along the shore line of Lake Nipissing to a point where the westerly limits of the City intersects with said shore line. Thence northerly to the Northern boundary of the said City; Thence easterly along the northerly boundary to the centre line of Douglas Street; Thence southerly along the centre line of Front Street; Thence easterly along the centre line of Front Street to the centre line of Third Avenue; Thence southerly along the centre line of Third Avenue to the centre line of Commerical Street; Thence westerly along the centre line of Commerical Street to the centre line of Klock avenue; Thence southerly along the centre line of Klock Avenue; and Klock Avenue produced to the point of beginning.

Ward No. 2

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Klock avenue, C ommerical Street, Third Avenue, Ferguson Street, King Street and Wyld Street, bounded as follows:-

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centre line of Regina Street produced with the shore line of Lake Nipissing, thence norwesterly along the shore line of Lake Nipissing to the point of intersection of said shore line with the centre line of Wyld Street produced; thence north easterly along the centre line of Wyld Street to its intersection with the centre line of Third Ave; thence South Easterly along the centre line of Third Ave, to its intersection with the the centre line of John Street;

thence South Westerly along the centre line of John Street to its intersection with the centre line of Oak Street; thence north westerly along the centre line of Oak Street to its intersection with the centre line of Regina Street and thence South Westerly along the centre line of Regina Street to its intersection with the shore line of Lake Nipissing the point of beginning.

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Regina Street, Oak Street, John Street, Third Avenue, Wyld Street, King Street, Wyld Street, Aubrey Street, Fisher Street, Fraser Street produced to the easterly boundary of the City, Widdifield Town line, Ferris Town line produced, Judge Avenue and the shores of Lake Nipissing, bounded as follows:-
