BEING A BY/LAW of the City of North Bay for dividing the City of North Bay into wards, and to provide for the number of aldermen to be elected in each Ward.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deem it expedient to divide the said City of North Bay into Wards as provided by the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section Forty-four (44) of the Consolidated Municipal Act, 1922, all the provisions have been duly carried out.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The City of North Bay shall be divided into Five (5) Wards.

2. The said wards shall be divided as follows:-

Subdivisions	1 - 2 - 3	Ward	1.
"	4 - 5 - 6	"	2.
"	7 - 8	"	3.
"	9 - 10	"	4.
"	11 - 12- 13	"	5.

As shown in Description Schedule "A" attached.

3. The Council of the City of North Bay shall be composed of the Mayor and two aldermen elected from each Ward as above set forth.

This By-Law shall come into effect if it receives the assent of the Municipal Electors on the Sixth day of December A. D. 1926, being the date of the Municipal election for the Municipal Council.

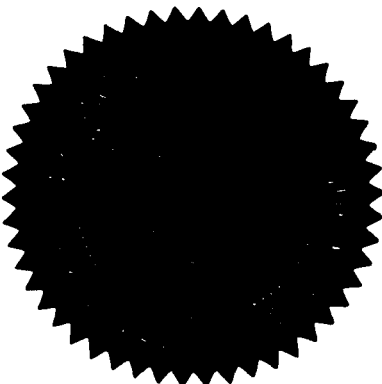

WARDS-- 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, of the City of North Bay.

SUMMARIES DESCRIPTIONS

Ward No. 1

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying West of Klock Avenue, North of Commerical Street, West of Third Avenue, South of Front Street and West of Douglas Street, and bounded as follows:-

On the South-West by Lake Nipissing from a point at the intersection where the centre line of Klock Avenue produced Southerly intersects the shores of Lake Nipissing thence in a North westerly direction along the shore line of Lake Nipissing to a point where the westerly limits of the City intersects with said shore line. Thence northerly to the Northern boundary of the said City; Thence easterly along the northerly boundary to the centre line of Douglas Street; Thence southerly along the centre line of Douglas Street; to the centre line of Front Street; Thence easterly along the centre line of Front Street to the centre line of Third Avenue; Thence southerly along the centre line of Third Avenue to the centre line of Commerical Street; Thence westerly along the centre line of Commerical Street to the centre line of Klock avenue; Thence southerly along the centre line of Klock Avenue; and Klock Avenue produced to the point of beginning.

Ward No. 2

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Klock avenue, Commerical Street, Third Avenue, Ferguson Street, King Street and Wyld Street, bounded as follows:-

On the South-West by Lake Nipissing from a point where the centre line of Wyld Street produced intersects the shore line of said Lake; thence north-westerly along the shore of Lake Nipissing to a point where the centre line of Klock Avenue produced intersects said shore line; thence northerly along the centre line of Klock Ave. to the point of intersection with the centre line of Commerical Street; thence Easterly along the centre line of Commerical Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Third Ave; thence south easterly along the centre line of Third Ave, to the point of intersection with the centre line of Ferguson Street; thence North Easterly along the centre line of Ferguson Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of King Street; thence southerly along the centre line of King Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Wyld Street and thence south-westerly along the centre line of Wyld Street to the point of intersection with the shore line of Lake Nipissing the point of beginning.

Ward No. 3

All that Portion of the City of North Bay lying between Wyld Street, Third Avenue, John Street Oak Street, Regina Street and Lake Nipissing, bounded as follows:-

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centre line of Regina Street produced with the shore line of Lake Nipissing, thence Norwesterly along the shore line of Lake Nipissing to the point of intersection of said shore line with the centre line of Wyld Street produced; thence north easterly along the centre line of Wyld Street to its intersection with the centre line of Third Ave; thence South Easterly along the centre line of Third Ave, to its intersection with the the centre line of John Street;

thence South Westerly along the centre line of John Street to its intersection with the centre line of Oak Street; thence north westerly along the centre line of Oak Street to its intersection with the centre line of Regina Street and thence South Westerly along the centre line of Regina Street to its intersection with the shore line of Lake Nipissing the point of beginning.

Ward No. 4

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Regina Street, Oak Street, John Street, Third Avenue, Wyld Street, King Street, Wyld Street, Aubrey Street, Fisher Street, Fraser Street produced to the easterly boundary of the City, Widdifield Town line, Ferris Town line produced, Judge Avenue and the shores of Lake Nipissing, bounded as follows:-

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centre line of Regina Street produced with the *shore* line of Lake Nipissing; thence North Easterly along the centre line of Regina Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Oak Street; thence South Easterly along the centre line of Oak Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of John Street; thence North Easterly along the centre line of John Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Third Ave; thence North Westerly along the centre line of Third Avenue to the point of intersection with the centre line of Wyld Street; thence North Easterly along the centre line of Wyld Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of King Street thence northerly along the centre line of King Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Wyld Street; thence easterly along the centre line of Wyld Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Aubrey Street; thence Southerly along the centre line of Aubrey Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Fisher Street; thence North Easterly along the centre line of Fisher Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Fraser Street; thence easterly along the centre line of Fraser Street produced to the Easterly Boundary of the City of North Bay; thence Southerly along the boundary line between the City of North Bay and the Township of Widdifield to the Boundary line between the Townships of Widdifield and West Ferris; thence South Westerly along the boundary between the Township of West Ferris and the City of North Bay to the point of intersection with the shore line of Lake Nipissing; and thence North-Westerly along the Shore line of Lake Nipissing to the intersection of the centre line of Regina Street produced the point of beginning.

Ward No. 5

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying, between Douglas street, Front Street, Third Ave. Ferguson Street, King Street, Wyld Street, Aubrey Street, Fisher Street, Fraser Street produced, the Easterly limits of the City of North Bay and the Northerly limits of the City of North Bay, bounded as follows:-

Commencing at the intersection of the centre line of Douglas Street with the Northerly boundary of the North Bay; thence Southerly along the centre line of Douglas Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Front Street; thence easterly along the center line of Front Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Third Ave. thence Southerly along the centre line of Third Avenue to the point of intersection with the centre line of Commerical Street; thence south Easterly along the Centre line of Third Avenue to the point of intersection with the centre line of Ferguson Street; thence North Easterly along the Centre line of Ferguson Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of King Street; thence Southerly along the centre line, of King Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Wyld Street; thence Easterly along the centre line of Wyld Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Aubray Street; thence Southerly along the centre line of Aubray Street, ~~to the centre line of Aubray Street~~ to the point of intersection with the centre line of Fisher Street; thence North-Easterly along the centre line of Fisher Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Fraser Street; thence Easterly along the centre line of Fraser Street produced to the Easterly boundary of the City of North Bay; thence northerly along the Easterly boundary line between the City of North Bay and the Townships of Widdifield to the Northerly Boundary of the City of North Bay, and thence Westerly along the Northerly boundary line between the City of North Bay and the Township of Widdifield to the centre line of Douglas Street, the point of beginning.

DIVISION OF CITY OF NORTH BAY INTO WARDS

BY/LAW NUMBER

BEING a By-law of the City of North Bay, for dividing the City of North Bay into Wards, and to provided for a number of Aldermen to be elected in each Ward.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deem it expedient to divide the said City of North Bay into Wards as provided by the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS PURSUANT To Section Forty-Four (44) of the Consolidated Municipal Act, 1922, all the provisions have been duly carried out.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :-

1. The City of North Bay shall be divided into Five (5) Wards.
2. The said Wards shall be divided as follows:-

Subdivisions	1 - 2 - 3	Ward	1
"	4 - 5 - 6	"	2
"	7 - 8	"	3
"	9 - 10	"	4
"	11 - 12 - 13	"	5

As shown in Description Schedule "A" attached.

3. The Council of the City of North Bay shall be composed of the Mayor and two aldermen elected from each Ward as above set forth.

This By-law shall come into effect if it receives the assent of the Municipal Electors on the sixth day of December A. D. 1926, being the date of the Municipal election for the Municipal Council.

SCHEDULE "A"

Ward No.1

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying West of Klock Avenue, North of Commercial Street, West of Third Avenue, South of Front Street and West of Douglas Street.

Ward No.2

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Klock Avenue, Commercial Street, Third Avenue, Ferguson Street, King Street and Wyld Street.

Ward No.3

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Wyld Street, Third Avenue, John Street, Oak Street, Regina Street and Lake Nipissing.

Ward No.4

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Regina Street, Oak Street, John Street, Third Avenue, Wyld Street, King Street, Wyld Street, Aubry Street, Fisher Street, Fraser Street produced to the easterly boundary of the City, Widdifield Town line, Ferris Town line produced Judge Avenue and the shores of Lake Nipissing.

Ward No.5

All that portion of the City of North Bay lying between Douglas Street, Front Street, Third Avenue, Ferguson Street, King Street, Wyld Street, Aubry Street, Fisher Street, Fraser Street produced, the Easterly limits of the City of the City of North Bay and the Northerly Limits of the City of North Bay.

Take notice that the above is a true copy of the proposed By-law, and if the consent of the electors is obtained, it will be taken into consideration by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay after the expiration of one month from the Fifth day of November, A. D. 1926.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT

The votes of the duly qualified electors of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall be taken on the said questions at the same time and at the same places as the annual election for the Municipal Council, and the Deputy Returning Officers appointed to hold said election shall take the vote.

On the 30th day of November A. D. 1926, at the hour of Two O'Clock in the afternoon, the head of the Council of the said Corporation of the City of North Bay, or some member of said Council appointed for that purpose by resolution shall attend at the Council Chamber in the said Municipality for the purpose of appointing, and, if requested so to do, shall appoint by writing signed by him, two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk, and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and promoting the proposed By-law and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and opposing the proposed By-law.
