CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO 932

BEING a By-Law to authorize the construction of bithulithic pavement on certain streets in the city of North Bay as a Local Improvement under the provisions of the Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS P. E. McCool, F. W. McKee and James A. Lambertus and others have petitioned the Municipal Council to construct as a local improvement the work hereinafter described, and the Clerk has certified that the Petition is sufficient, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the Petition in the manner hereinafter provided.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- l. That bithulithic pavement be constructed on Copeland Street in the City of North Bay as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached and which forms part of this By-Law as a local improvement under the provisions of the Local Improvement Act together with all necessary private drain connections and alterations or renewals of water service pipes and stopcocks to the line of the street.
- 2. That the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- 3. That the work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence of and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.
- 4. That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the execution of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- 5. That the Treasurer may (subject to the approval of the Council) agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
- 6. The special assessment shall be paid by twenty equal annual instalments.
- 7. That the debentures to be issued for the loan to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and to be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan.
- 8. That any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the costs of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk, and at any time thereafter by payment of such sum as when invested at 5% per annum will provide an annuity sufficient to pay the special rates for the unexpired portion of the term as they fall due.
