BY-LAW NUMBER 600

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for the extension of the Sanitary Sewerage System on certain streets within the limits of the Town of North Bay, and all necessary drain connections to the street line on either or both sides under the provisions of the Local Improvement Act, and to authorize the making of an Agreement for temporary advances to meet the cost thereof.

WHEREAS petitions have been presented to the Council of the Town of North Bay in accordance with an Act respecting Local Improvements, for the construction under the provisions of the said Act, a Sanitary Sewer on the streets of parts of streets of the said Town as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached, which petitions were signed respectively by at least two-thirds in number of the owners representing at least one-half of the value of the lots liable to be specially assessed, as appears by the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality, and the number of such owners and the value of such lots liable to be specially assessed appears by the last revised Assessment Roll aforesaid, having been ascertained finally determined in accordance with and as provided for, by the said Act,

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that the system of Sanitary Sewerage and connections thereto, existing in the Town of North Bay should be extended along certain streets, within the limits of the said Town, and that it is desirable that the said work should be undertaken as Local Improvement,

AND WHEREAS the Local Board of Health has reported in writing that it is of the opinion that it is necessary in the interests of the Public Health that the Sanitary Sewerage System at present existing in the said Town, should be extended, for which plans, specifications and applications have been approved of by the Provincial Board of Health, being as follows:-

"We hereby certify that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay have submitted to this Board plans, specifications and an application of Sewer extensions:

Oak Street	Fraser St.	Cassells St.

at a total estimated cost of One Thousand and Ninety-Four Dollars

(\\$1094.00) and that this Board has inquired into and reported upon the work to be undertaken as to whether the same is calculated to meet the sanitary requirements of the inhabitants affected thereby, and as to whether such works are likely to prove prejudicial to the health of the inhabitants of the Municipality or of any other Municipality liable to be affected thereby, and that the construction of said work has been approved by the Board."

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay considers it necessary, and by this By-law passed at a general meeting of the Council of the said Town by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, hereby declares that said sewerage system with necessary connections at present existing in the said Town, should be extended along the streets referred to in Schedule "A" attached to this By-law, between the points mentioned in the said Schedule as a Local Improvement,

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay by this By-law passed at a general meeting of the Council of the said Town, by a vote of three-fourths of all the members thereof hereby provides that the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per foot frontage shall be specially assessed upon the land directly abutting on the work, as well as the total cost of all necessary drain connections, and that the remainder of the cost of such sewers shall be borne by the Corporation,

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY, as follows:-

- (1) The Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, upon the recommendation of the Local Board of Health, and approval of the Provincial Board of Health, hereby declares that the extension of its sewerage system as a Local Improvement is necessary and desirable in the Public interests on sanitary grounds.
- (2) That the said sewerage system be so extended along the streets and between the points referred to in Schedule "A" attached to this By-law, together with all necessary private drain connections.
- (3) That the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per foot frontage shall be specially assessed upon the land abutting directly on the work, as well as the total cost of all necessary drain connections and that

the remainder of the cost of such sewer shall be borne by the Corporation.

(4) That the Municipal Council of the said Town may agree with the Royal Bank of Canada or any other bank or person for temporary advances to meet the cost of the work, pending the completion of the same.

PASSED in open Council this 20th day of September, at a regular meeting of the Council, Eight (8) members of the said Council having voted in favour of this By-law and No members against same.
